

## World Badge Beetle



Each element of the World Badge has a specific meaning:

The golden Trefoil on a bright blue background represents the sun shining over all the children of the world

The three leaves represent the three-fold Promise as originally laid down by the Founder

The base of the stalk represents the flame of the love of humanity

The vein pointing upwards through the centre of the Trefoil is the compass needle pointing the way; and the two stars represent the Promise and Law.

Get your members to either print off a picture of a world badge or get them to make your own. They could colour in the below and cut it into segments to play the game.

This game would also be good to play virtually as long as everyone has access to dice.

Take it in turns to throw the dice, you must throw a six to start. They can only collect one piece per throw of the dice. Each time they pick up a piece they must position it correctly and say what it symbolises.

The first to get a complete World Badge wins!



1 = the needle

2 = a star

3 = the stalk

4 = a leaf of the trefoil

5 = the outer ring

6 = the blue background circle
